“Call for Nomination for District Committees

1. At the District Executive Council meeting on June 19th, 2018 the following motion to strike a District committee was presented and passed.

DISTRICT LEVY WORKGROUP:

BIRT District Executive Council be directed by the District AGM to strike a workgroup of seven (7) members equally distributed between the Bargaining Units, if possible, to investigate various options for the District Levy and the impact on Members. The workgroup will present their findings to the 2019 District AGM. The District Treasurer will allocate an operating budget of \$1,000.00 for the workgroup.

2. At the District Annual General Meeting on May 29th, 2018 the following motion to strike a District committee was presented and passed.

DISTRICT TREASURER WORKGROUP:

BIRT District Executive Council be directed by the District AGM to strike a workgroup of seven (7) members equally distributed between the Bargaining Units, if possible, to investigate various options for the District Treasurer compensation and the impact on the members. The workgroup will present their findings to the 2019 District AGM. The Treasurer will allocate an operating budget of \$1,000.00 for the workgroup.

3. In conjunction with the District 18 OSSTF Constitution By Law 15 the District Executive Council shall form the District Parliamentary Committee annually.



DISTRICT CONSTITUTION COMMITTEE:

“The committee shall review the Constitution and By-Laws to prepare proposed Constitutional and By-Law changes for review by the District Executive Council in preparation for the purpose of producing on-time motions for the Annual General Meeting.”

In order to move forward to create these workgroups/committees we are requesting interested members submit a brief summary (200-300 words) of their interest in the issue in order to be considered a candidate by the District Executive Council. Interested members should outline any experiences, knowledge and or skills both in the Federation and outside that may assist them to be an engaged workgroup/committee member.

Interested members should forward their summary/application to the District President (paul.rawlinson@d18.osstf.ca). The summary should be clearly labelled as to which workgroup/committee the application is intended.
